

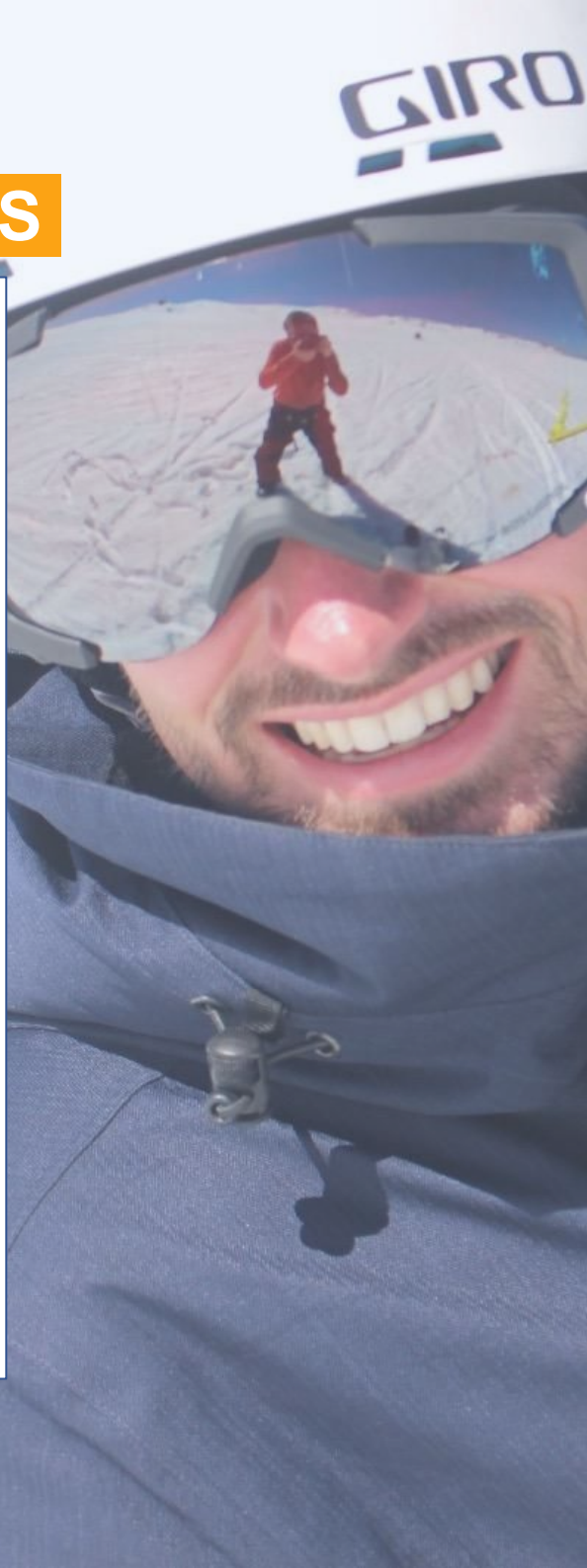

YOUR SNOWKITE LESSONS

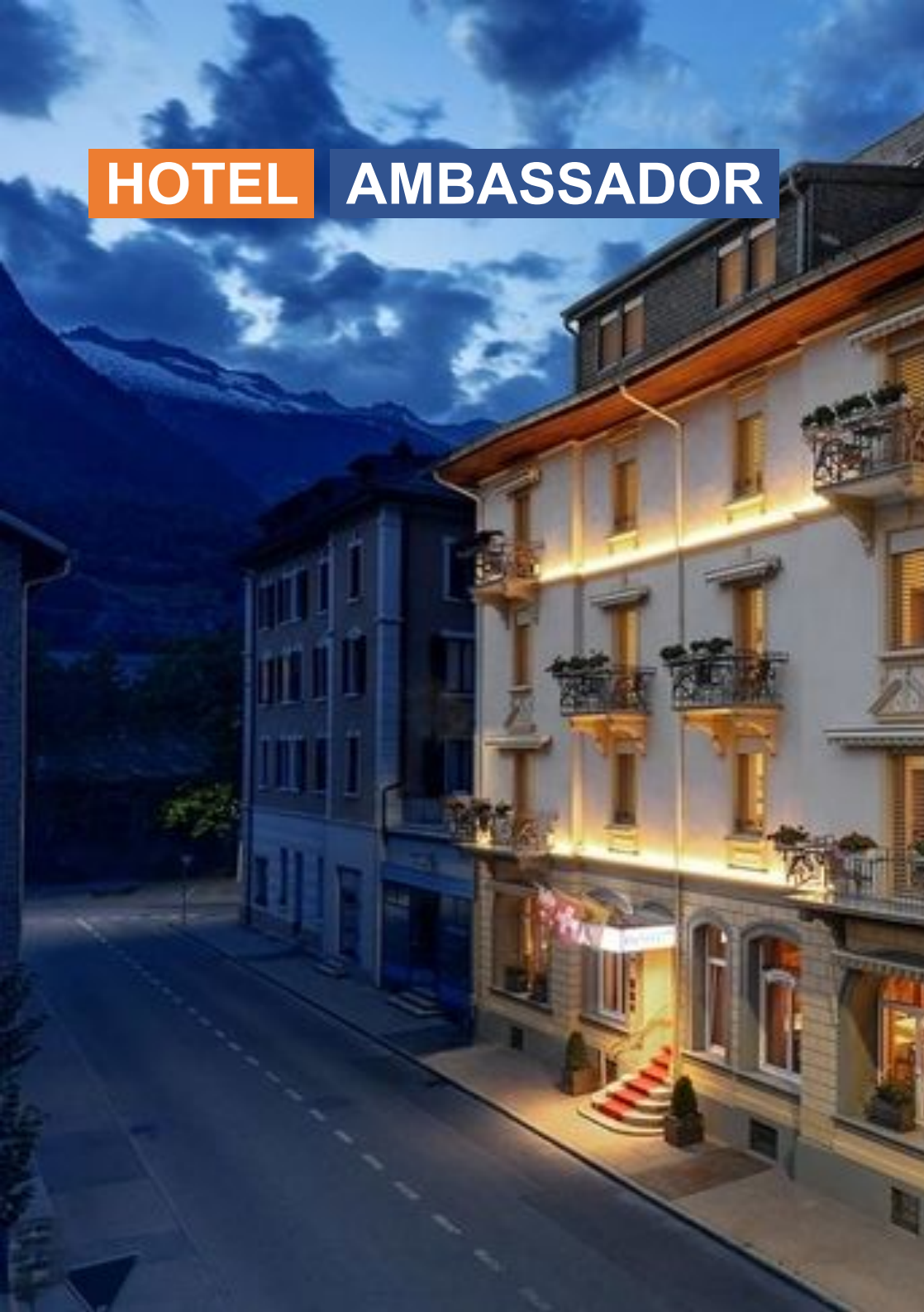

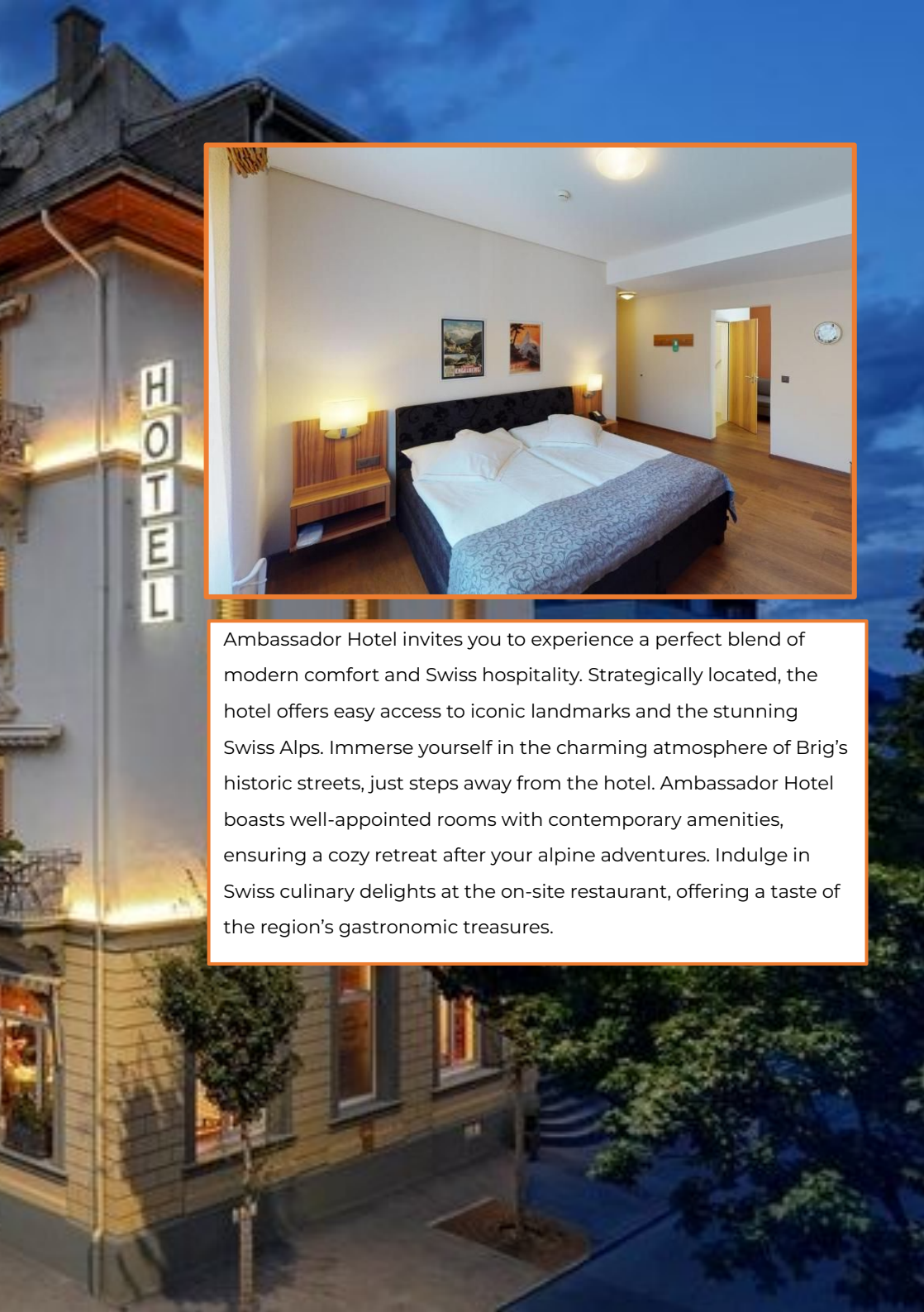

Snowkiting is enjoyable on any type of snow: powder, sludge snow, ice (frozen lakes). This makes it a very flexible sport that can be practiced in many different locations as long as they are windy enough. Rest assured, snowkite beginners who already know how to kite and ski/snowboard will be able to manage on their first session!

immerse yourself in the region's history with a visit to the Stockalper Palace, a Swiss heritage site of national significance. This stunning palace, constructed between 1658 and 1678 by Kaspar Stockalper, a silk merchant of Brig, provides a glimpse into the rich heritage of this region. Additionally, Brig has strong ties to the Simplon Pass, one of the most picturesque Alpine crossings that begins right beyond the city's gates. A significant piece of history, Napoleon ordered the construction of a road through this pass in the 19th century, creating the first man-made road in the Alps.
